Preventing Injuries while Gardening

The Reedsburg Area Medical Center Rehabilitation Department will demonstrate proper movements to prevent the “ouch” while gardening. Therapists will invite participants to join in doing the simple exercises and techniques to use during both the active gardening season and off-season. Dress in comfortable clothing to participate if desired.

Dividing & Planting for Next Year’s Garden

Phyllis Both, Sauk County UW Extension Horticulture Educator and Sauk County MGs will demonstrate best ways to divide perennials and share which ones benefit from fall division. She’ll also discuss bulbs to plant for spring/early summer blooming and provide tips on preventing damage from garden rodents.

Garden Journaling

As we enter the dormant season, journaling offers an opportunity to review the season and plan for the next. MGV Carrie Covell will present and show examples of several different journaling styles and demonstrate several methods of creating a unique journal with tips for collecting, compiling and curating the ephemera and data of the gardening experience. Participants will leave with a mini-journal to launch (or continue) their journaling journey.

Demonstration Instructors
